Andrew joined CPSL in 2008 to lead work with groups of international insurers, banks and investors, driving collaboration, learning and change to build a financial system that values a sustainable future.

In this role, he supports ten of the world's largest banks from China, Europe, Japan and the United States that were convened by their Chief Executives to direct capital towards environmentally sustainable economic development. Andrew leads collaborations between bankers and groups of corporates to pioneer the alignment of banking services with client needs on subjects such as clean energy, soft commodity production and trade finance.

Since its inception Andrew has also led the team supporting ClimateWise, a group of 40 insurance and reinsurance companies from Africa, Asia, Europe and North America seeking to drive action on climate change risk. Amongst others, he has led partnerships between insurers and the energy sector on risk management strategies for Carbon Capture and Storage liabilities and between insurers, city authorities and infrastructure providers on building resilient cities.

Prior to joining CPSL, Andrew worked at the UK Government Department for Business and the international insurer RSA. He has co-authored publications on city and regional development for the OECD, holds a Masters in Leadership for Sustainable Development and a Bachelors degree in Geography from the University of Oxford.
