

John Tobin Global Head of Sustainability Affairs, Credit Suisse

John Tobin-de la Puente is a Managing Director of Credit Suisse, based in Zurich, where he is Global Head of Sustainability Affairs, and has responsibility for managing environmental and social matters at the bank. Prior to his current function, Dr. Tobin was in the Legal and Compliance Department of Credit Suisse in New York, where he was responsible for legal aspects of the bank's emerging markets business, with a focus on Latin America. He joined Credit Suisse from Clifford Chance in New York, where he was a corporate attorney focusing on cross-border financial transactions, and prior to that he worked as a corporate attorney at Davis Polk & Wardwell in New York. Dr. Tobin holds a Ph.D. in Evolutionary Biology from Harvard University as well as a J.D. from Harvard Law School. He obtained his B.S. in Biology from the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA). Among other appointments, Dr. Tobin is Treasurer of the American Institute of Biological Sciences, and is a member of the board of directors of the Organization for Tropical Studies, of the Private Sector Advisory Group of the United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction (UNISDR), and of the Environment and Energy Commission of the International Chamber of Commerce.
